Select Board Meeting Minutes
April 8, 2025 at 6:15 pm

In Attendance: Gary Dube, Eric Demers, Joshua Ewalt, Colin Wentworth, Fire Chief Chapman, Jim Ottolini, Tammi Dube

Call to Order: Gary Dube called the meeting to order at 6:15 pm.

Pledge of Allegiance:

- All present stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Discussion with Road Agent:

- Mutual Aid Project List: The board asked Colin to make a list of projects that he would like to do in conjunction with Stark's Road Agent as part of the Mutual Aid Agreement that is being discussed.
- The board and Colin discussed the recall on the Mack Truck for an ABS issue.
- The board and Colin inspected the Library grounds regarding damage done over the winter. Pavers and sandbox garden will be replaced and the pavers will be reset.
- The board and Colin discussed road conditions on the Jewett Hill section of Blake Road. Colin will look at the road and talk to Dennis Jewett and see what can be done.
- The board and Colin discussed getting gravel quotes for the road repairs to be done this summer.
- The garage door has been installed. The other garage door will eventually need a new motor.

Scheduled Visitor, Fire Chief Chapman 6:30:

- The board and Chief Chapman discussed the Place of Assembly Permit.
- Word of God Christian Church, Revival Tent Meeting: The board and Chief Chapman discussed the upcoming revival. We will keep the Chief updated on crowds expected.
- The Fire Dept does not have a door code for the building.

- E911 Data to UNH
 - Joshua Ewalt made a motion to release rural addressing data from E911 to map broadband in Dummer.

- Eric Demers seconded. All voted in favor.
- Library Exhaust Fan: The board is still researching and will order a fan soon. The board also discussed methods to keep water away from the foundation, removing the remaining 2x4s and painting/sealing the foundation.
- Headstone Repair & Resetting: Nothing to report at this time.
- MS-9 Report of the Trust Funds: The board reviewed the MS-9 Report of the Trust Funds.

New Business:

- Bank Account Reconciliations: The board reviewed and signed the bank account reconciliations.
- P&L Budget vs Actual Quarterly Report: The board reviewed the quarterly reports.
- Word of God Christian Church, Revival Tent Meeting, October 3-5, 2025: The board discussed the upcoming revival, no permits are required.
- Road Ban Exception Request: The board reviewed correspondence requesting a waiver. The road referred to is a state road, NH DOT would need to be contacted by the resident.

- DRA Correspondence, Article 17: The board reviewed correspondence from DRA regarding Warrant Article 17 which was reworded at town meeting. DRA recommends putting the reworded article on next year's warrant.

Public Participation: There was no public in attendance.


Motion to Adjourn: Eric Demers made a motion to adjourn; Joshua Ewalt seconded the motion; all voted in favor.
